Abstracts should be submitted (.doc, .docx, .odt) in form.

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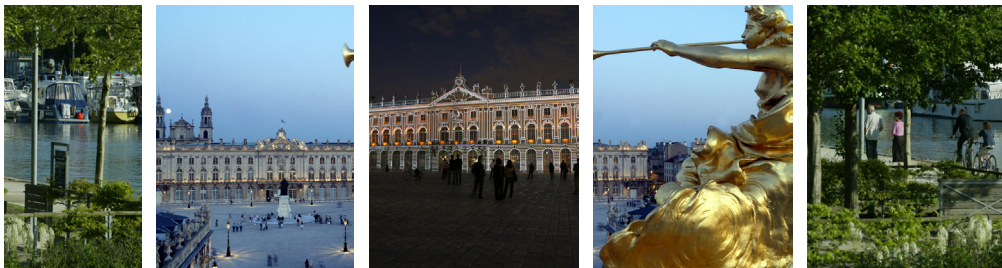

Nancy

Strategically located in the heart of Western Europe, the city is known for its UNESCO's World Heritage building and its «Place Stanislas». At the turn of the 20th century, Nancy was a major centre of the Art Nouveau movement with the School of Nancy.



Louis Camille Maillard

He was born in Pont-à-Mousson 4 February 1878. At 16 years he joined the faculty of medicine at Nancy and also developed research in chemistry that hold the attention of the scientific world. He became doctor in medicine at the age of 25. During his thesis he discovered the chemical reaction between amino acids and sugars known as the «Maillard reaction». His first paper related to the Maillard reaction was published in 1912 (100 years ago).
